


The following is a diagram of the School Social Work tiered support for student services:



Tier 3 (Few)

- Crisis Intervention--immediate support to school and parent/guardian
- Behavior/Educational Support for identified students (Child Study, Special Education Team Meetings, BIP Meetings)
- School Social Work Referral (i.e. medical, social, behavioral, etc.)
- Suicidal Prevention and Assessment—referrals to local agencies to further assess (e.g. CHKD, Maryview Hospital, Portsmouth Department of Behavioral Health, etc.)
- Advocacy for student/families and school



Tier 2 (Some)

- Crisis Intervention
- School Social Work Referral (e.g. medical, social, behavioral, etc.)
- Provide support for CPS referrals
- Facilitate social-emotional skills groups as needed
- Linkage to Community Resources
- Provide student observations
- Advocacy for student/families and school
- Mediation support
- Support school-based agencies and departments as needed
- Participate in school-based meetings



Tier 1 (Universal)

- In-services: (Annual Orientation with Faculty and Staff and Other trainings/presentations as needed)
 - Informing Staff of School Social Work Referral Process
 - Participating in school-based parent/student events
 - Linkage to Community Resources
 - Advocacy for student, families and school
 - Collaborate with community and school-based agencies
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
